1. General Rules:

- a. Masks must be worn at all times on the bus and on campus (ONLY exceptions are during breakfast and lunch while seated and actively eating) Prepare for 6 hours of mask wearing each day of in- person learning.
- b. Staff will remain 6 feet from students at all times. Elementary students will stay at least 3 feet apart at all times. Secondary students maintain 6-foot distancing.
- c. Frequent hand washing/ sanitizing is encouraged.
- d. Daily temperature checks of students required of families.
- e. Students with symptoms of any kind should be kept at home and school notified of absence and symptoms.
- f. No loitering in hallways during passing periods. "Stay in your lane" while traveling in the halls- - on the right side of the hallway, physically distanced from others.
- g. Lockers and locker rooms
- h. No lockers or locker room use at any time.
- i. Each student will carry their backpack/ bookbag and supplies with them all day.
- j. Students will bring the following supplies to school each in-person day
- k. Charged Chromebook
- l. Student agenda/ planner
- m. Pencils, pens, supplies for success in academics
- n. Empty water bottle with name of student (supplied by OCS)
- o. Textbooks

2. General Safety Information

- a. All staff will be sanitizing classrooms and restrooms frequently during the day
- b. Air purifiers have been distributed to each classroom.
- c. Windows will be opened in classrooms when weather permits
- d. Any noncompliance with safety measures will result in student exclusion
- e. Students who become ill during the day will be checked by the school nurse and isolated until guardians can pick them up. (Further information in Covid-19 Response Guide from ECSD)

- f. All staff and students complete a wellness checklist before entering the building. Visitors by appointment only.



3. Bus Procedures

- a. Students will be assigned seats on the bus and wear masks at all times.
- b. Students will follow directions of Staff.
- c. Entering and exiting the bus is a hands-free activity.
- d. No “occasional” rides will be allowed. Students must either ride the bus always (unless ill) or always ride with parent/ guardian.

4. Breakfast and Lunch

- a. Each student upon arriving at school, will report to the cafeteria using the designated doorway. (HH) Elementary students in line to the right and Secondary in line to the left of the hallway.
- b. Elementary students will be seated in their assigned seats after receiving breakfast. Secondary students will proceed to their assigned homeroom/ Braves Block class after receiving breakfast. No other options.
- c. All students, K- 12 will be assigned seating in the gym and times for lunch. No other options.
- d. Breakfast and lunches will continue to be the “sack lunch” style that you are getting now, so we can have breakfast and lunch distribution for those in virtual learning. The times for pickup of meals for virtual learners will be after all in school scheduled lunches are finished for the day. Only one pick up time provided daily.

5. Classroom Learning and Virtual Learning

- a. In person learning and virtual learning will be happening at the same time.
- b. School is 5 days a week regardless of the student’s location. Students will continue to fill out attendance form for daily virtual times at school.
- c. Students at home will be required to learn along with others from their device.
- d. “A” schedule is Monday- in person, Tuesday- in person, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday- virtual.
- e. “B” schedule is Monday- virtual, Tuesday- virtual, Wednesday- in person, Thursday- in person, Friday- virtual.
- f. In- person learners will complete assignments on Chromebooks while in class. Remember to charge your device each evening as we do not have plug capability for each Chromebook.

6. Fridays

- a. All students will participate in virtual learning every Friday.
- b. Staff will be conducting more thorough cleaning at the end of each week.

7. Recess

- a. Each class cohort will have one morning recess with their teacher in attendance.
- b. No other classes on the playground area at the same time.
- c. Each class has been given playground equipment. Activities will be distanced with no sharing of equipment allowed for safety.
 - i. PreK & Kindergarten will attend school in-person Monday through Thursday
